TERMS AGREEMENT

The undersigned ("Purchaser/Lessee") agree that all purchases/rentals made by ("Purchaser/Lessee") from ABCO=BRAMER or any of its subsidiaries or affiliated entities ("Seller/Lessor") are subject to the following terms and conditions. If a Purchase Order number is required, it is the responsibility of the Purchaser/Lessee to supply this number before or at time of purchase/rental.

In making this application for commercial credit, I/we understand and agree to your terms of payment: NET DUE UPON RECEIPT on all approved accounts and service charges of 1.5% per month on all invoices/contracts not paid within terms. Any disputed invoices must be brought to the attention of the Seller/Lessor within fifteen (15) days of receipt of invoice in writing by the Purchaser/Lessee. If the Seller/Lessor is not notified, then the invoices/contracts are deemed correct and undisputed.

If credit is granted and collection thereof requires the assistance of attorneys, I/we agree that you reserve the right to bring legal action in whatever jurisdiction you deem necessary, whose laws, at the option of the Seller/Lessor, shall govern this agreement. In the event ABCO=BRAMER finds it necessary to turn over my/our accounts to a collection agency or attorney, I/we agree to pay all cost and expenses of collection, including but not limited to attorney's fees and expenses.

The Company/Individual agrees that whoever signs this application for credit is authorized to do so, unless ABCO=BRAMER is otherwise notified in writing. I/We authorize ABCO=BRAMER to make whatever inquires it deems necessary in connection with this application.

A certificate of insurance listing ABCO=BRAMER as a "Loss Payee" (Inland Marine) and "additionally insured" (General Liability) must be provided prior to the rental delivery/pickup or the Company/Individual is subject to a charge for Loss and Damage Waiver. Coverage should be for Contractor's Equipment or Leased or Rented Equipment in an amount that would cover your rental requirements, that is, the replacement cost of all equipment rented. Certificate must state policy limits and deductible amounts.

INDIVIDUAL PERSONAL GUARANTY

I expressly waive presentment, demand, protest, notice of protest, dishonor, diligence, notice of default or nonpayment, notice of acceptance of this guaranty, notice of extending of any guaranteed indebtedness already of hereafter contracted for by the Company, notice of any modifications or renewal of any credit agreement evidencing the indebtedness hereby guaranteed to all renewals of extensions of such indebtedness from, the Company or any other party liable for such indebtedness.

I, the personal guarantor, waive my homestead exemption as to this debt, and waive notice of maturity, presentment, demand, and protest. If the guaranteed indebtedness is not paid by me when due (after formal demand of payment), and this guaranty displaced in the hands for collection, suit is brought hereon, or it is enforced through any judicial proceeding whatsoever, I shall pay all cost and expense of collection, including but not limited to attorney's fees and expenses.

In the event more than one (1) party executed this guaranty as a guarantor, then each guarantor agrees to be jointly and severally liable for the guaranteed indebtedness, and, in all instances herein, the singular shall be construed to include the plural.

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Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must get your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to give your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

1. Certify the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
2. Certify you are not subject to backup withholding, or
3. Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee.

If you are a foreign person, use the appropriate Form W-8. See Pub. 515, Withholding of Tax on Nonresident Aliens and Foreign Corporations.

Note: If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

What is backup withholding? Persons making certain payments to you must withhold and pay to the IRS 31% of such payments under certain conditions. This is called "backup withholding." Payments that may be subject to backup withholding include interest, dividends, broker and barter exchange transactions, rents, royalties, nonemployee pay, and certain payments from fishing boat operators. Real estate transactions are not subject to backup withholding.

If you give the requester your correct TIN, make the proper certifications, and report all your taxable interest and dividends on your tax return, payments you receive will not be subject to backup withholding. **Payments you receive will be subject to backup withholding if:**

1. You do not furnish your TIN to the requester, or
2. You do not certify your TIN when required (see the Part III instructions on page 2 for details), or
3. The IRS tells the requester that you furnished an incorrect TIN, or
4. The IRS tells you that you are subject to backup withholding because you did not report all your interest and dividends on your tax return (for reportable interest and dividends only), or

5. You do not certify to the requester that you are not subject to backup withholding under 4 above (for reportable interest and dividend accounts opened after 1983 only).

Certain payees and payments are exempt from backup withholding. See the Part II instructions and the separate **Instructions for the Requester of Form W-9**.

Penalties

Failure to furnish TIN. If you fail to furnish your correct TIN to a requester, you are subject to a penalty of \$50 for each such failure unless your failure is due to reasonable cause and not to willful neglect.

Civil penalty for false information with respect to withholding. If you make a false statement with no reasonable basis that results in no backup withholding, you are subject to a \$500 penalty.

Criminal penalty for falsifying information. Willfully falsifying certifications or affirmations may subject you to criminal penalties including fines and/or imprisonment.

Misuse of TINs. If the requester discloses or uses TINs in violation of Federal law, the requester may be subject to civil and criminal penalties.
